

# Vocational Nurse (VN) Program

The VN program is offered twice a year in **January** and **September**.

## Class Schedule

- 18-month program (1530 hours)
- 3 days a week (days vary)
- 3 Segments

## Requirements to be considered for the VN Program

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Pass a Level A TABE test with a score of 11 or above
- Submit a VN Application **3 months prior** to the start date along with the following:
  - High School Diploma or High School Equivalency
  - Nurse Assistant Certification
  - Proof of 350 hours of employment as a CNA
  - 2 letters of recommendation (*from anyone except family*)
  - Government issued photo I.D
  - Birth Certificate
  - Social Security Card
  - One 2x2 passport photo
  - Basic Life Support (BLS) **American Heart** CPR

## Requirements upon ACCEPTANCE into the VN Program

### Health Requirements

- CAE Student Questionnaire
- CAE Physical Exam Form
- CAE Immunization form including:
  - 2- step TB skin Test, Hepatitis B Positive Titer
  - Varicella, MMR, Tdap
  - Covid-19 vaccine and Flu shot (both required)

### Additional Requirements

- American Databank - Background Check, Drug Screening & Immunization Tracker

### Uniform & Supplies

- 2 designated forest green scrub tops, bottoms, & 1 lab coat
- Wristwatch with a second hand (no smart watches)
- All white nursing shoes
- Penlight, stethoscope, & bandage scissors
- Access to a laptop/PC & reliable internet **REQUIRED**
  - cell phones are **NOT** acceptable
