CLINICAL (20 hours) upon completion of theory

- Wed 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm (split schedule) •
- Mon 6:30 am to 3:00 pm
- Tues 6:30 am to 3:00 pm

## Requirements to enter the HHA Class

- Must have an ACTIVE Nurse Assistant Certification
- Must have an American Heart (BLS)CPR Certification
- Government issued photo I.D & Social Security Card
- Access to a laptop/PC & reliable internet REQUIRED
  - Cell Phones NOT acceptable as main device

# Requirements for the FIRST day of class

### **Health Requirements**

- CAE Student Health Questionnaire
- CAE Physical Exam Form •
- Negative TB skin test or Chest X-ray (only if needed) •
- Flu shot in current season (mandatory) •
- Hepatitis B series of 3 or positive Hep B Surface AB titer •
- Covid-19 vaccine & Covid booster (mandatory) •

### Uniform

- Solid colored matching scrub top and bottom • No prints on scrubs
- White nursing shoes (no canvas or tennis shoes)
- Hair must be up and out of face
- No fake lashes or nails allowed •

### Supplies

- Watch with a second hand (smart watches NOT acceptable) •
- Stethoscope
- Gait belt
- Notebook & Pens
