The NA part time program is available 2 times a year in February and September.

## Requirements to be considered for the NA Program

- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Pass TABE placement tests in Reading and Math
- Valid government issued photo I.D
- Valid Social Security Card
- OR Individual Taxpayers Identification Number (ITIN)
- Submit a NA Application (accepted on a first come basis, application deadline is 3 months before start date)

## Requirements upon ACCEPTANCE into the NA Program

## Attend a Mandatory Orientation (Date will be given in letter) Health Requirements

- CAE Physical Examination Form
- CAE Student Health Questionnaire
- CAE Immunization Form
  - Flu shot (for current season)
  - Negative TB (within 3 months of program start date)
  - Hepatitis B Vaccine (series of 3 or first injection started)
  - **OR** Positive Hepatitis B Surface Antibody(AB) Titer
  - Covid-19 vaccine & Covid Booster
- American Heart Basic Life Support (BLS) CPR card

## **Uniforms & Supplies**

- 2 designated Navy-Blue scrub tops, bottoms & 1 lab coat
- All White Nursing Shoes (no canvas or tennis shoes)
- Watch with a second hand (no smart watches allowed)

## Additional Requirements

- Background Check/Fingerprinting (on 2nd day of class)
- Access to a laptop/PC and reliable internet <u>REQUIRED</u>
