Requirements to be considered for the NA Program

- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Pass TABE placement tests in Reading and Math
- Submit an NA application with the following documents

*Government issued photo I.D (C.A license required) *Social Security Card OR Individual Taxpayers Identification Number (ITIN)

*American Heart Basic Life Support (BLS) CPR card

Original for all the above are required and CAE will take a photocopy

Requirements upon ACCEPTANCE into the NA Program

- CAE Physical Examination Form
- CAE Student Health Questionnaire
- CAE Immunization Form
 - Flu shot (for current season)
 - o 2 step Negative TB (within 3 months of program start date)
 - o Positive Hepatitis B Surface Antibody (AB) Titer
 - Covid-19 vaccine & Covid Booster

Uniforms & Supplies

- 2 designated Navy-Blue scrub tops, bottoms & 1 lab coat
- All White Nursing Shoes (no canvas or tennis shoes)
- Watch with a second hand (no smart watches allowed)

Additional Requirements

- Background Check/Fingerprinting (on 2nd day of class)
- Access to a laptop/PC and reliable internet <u>REQUIRED</u>
