The NA program is available twice a year in **February** and **September**.

- 14 week program (285 hours)
- 4 days a week

Morning Program

Monday –Thursday and one Saturday

AM Clinical 6:45 am –12:30 pm

Evening Program

Monday –Thursday and Saturdays

PM Theory 4:00 pm- 8:00 pm

PM Clinical 4:00 pm- 8:00 pm

Sat. Clinical 6:30 am- 12:45 pm

Requirements to be considered for the NA Program

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Pass a Level A TABE test with a score of 8.0 or above
- Submit a NA Application **3 months prior** to the start date to the Nursing and Allied Health Department in Rm A-8

Requirements upon acceptance in the NA Program

Health Requirements

- CAE Physical Examination Form
- CAE Student Health Questionnaire
- Immunizations
 - Flu shot (in season)
 - Negative TB *within 3 months of the program start date*
 - Hepatitis B Vaccine or proof of starting
- Basic Life Support American Heart CPR
- Background Check/Fingerprinting (on first day of class)

Program Cost

Program Fee

- \$1000 + books and supplies

Additional expenses up to \$500

- Books
- Immunizations
- Uniforms
- State Exam fee \$110.00 (*out of pocket expense*)
(*Fee due 3 weeks before graduation*)
