

# Vocational Nurse Program

The VN program is offered twice a year in **January** and **September**.

## Class Schedule

- 18 -20 month program (1530 hours)
- 3 days a week (days vary)
- 3 Segments

## Requirements to be considered for the VN Program

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Pass a Level A TABE test with a score of 11.0 or above
- High School Diploma or High School equivalency  
*(If you received your diploma outside of the U.S, see IMPORTANT NOTE)*
- Submit a VN Application **3 months prior** to the start date along with the following:
  - One 2x2 passport photo
  - Government issued photo I.D
  - Birth Certificate
  - Social Security Card
  - Current Nurse Assistant Certification
  - Proof of 2 months of employment as a CNA

*Originals for all the above are required and CAE will take a photocopy*

## Pre-Requisite Classes *(taken within 5 years of start date)*

- Medical Terminology 45 hrs
- Medical Math *(or Math 103/ Intermediate Algebra)* 45 hrs
- Nutrition *(or FN 40)* 33 hrs
- Anatomy & Physiology 60 hrs
- Computer Technology/Study Skills 36 hrs  
*(required to be taken at Clovis Adult Education)*

All the above classes are offered on our campus, 3 times a year in **January, May and September, one night a week. Ask if current schedule is available.**

## Requirements upon acceptance in the VN Program

### Health Requirements

- CAE Physical Exam Form/CAE Student Questionnaire
- Immunizations:
  - QFGold /Hepatitis B/Varicella/MMR/
  - Pertussis/TDap/ Flu shot*(in season)*/
- Basic Life Support American Heart CPR
- Background Check/Fingerprinting *(on first day of class)*

### Uniform

- Forest Green Scrub top and bottoms
- White Nursing Shoes

### Supplies

- Laptop strongly suggested or access to a computer

## Program Cost

### Program Fee

- \$12,000 + books and supplies
- Additional expenses up to \$3000

- immunizations
- uniforms
- State Exam \$700.00 *(not part of CAE fees)*
