Program Information & Schedule

Program is offered twice a year in **January** and in **September**

18-20 month program (1530 hours)

Program Fee: \$12,000.00 + cost of books & supplies

3 Days a week (days vary)

Additional expenses up to \$3000.00 (textbooks, supplies, exam fees, uniforms etc.)

3 Segments

Financial Aid is available for those who qualify

State Licensure Fee: \$500.00 (not part of CAE fees)

Requirements to be considered for the VN Program

- Must be at least 18 years old
- Pass a Level A TABE test at 11.0 or higher
- Vocational Nurse Application submitted to the Nursing Department
- High School Diploma or HSE *(if you received your diploma outside of the U.S, see IMPORTANT NOTE at bottom)*
- Current Nurse Assistant Certification
 - Must provide proof of employment as a CNA for a minimum of 2 months
- 2 Letters of Recommendation *(accepted from anyone other than family members)*

The following **pre-requisites** must be completed for the VN program and not older than 5 years:

If you have a degree from a foreign country, you must get your original transcripts/diplomas translated and evaluated from **North American Educational Group**.
